

JOB TITLE: Field Laborer

#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The purpose of this position is to travel to various job sites performing the installation of precast wall panels and planks, with a focus on safety and efficiency.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Install pre-cast products, including wall panel and planks, according to blueprint/design plans.
- Operating a fork-lift and man-lift.
- Rigging up various types of products to the cranes to ensure safe installation of precast products.
- Use correct crane signals to direct crane operators throughout the installation process.
- Managing equipment usage and tools to maintain efficiencies and meet schedules.
- Maintaining a logbook to enter drive times and schedules.
- Grout and tuck-point pre-cast products as required.
- Following instructions, guidelines, and procedures timely and accurately.
- Continually and actively seeking to learn new skills and progress in level of responsibility.
- Looks for ways to improve processes, reduce errors and increase efficiencies.
- Performing cleanup/housekeeping including putting away tools, sweeping debris and cleaning cluttered areas.
- Adhering to safety standards.
- Travel, sometimes overnight, to job sites.

### **NON-ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- Operating machinery, including saws and grout pumps.
- Operating overhead cranes.
- Driving yard vehicles including truck, trailer, and tractor on company grounds.

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

- Two (2) years previous experience working in a field environment required.
- Ability to read a tape measure and blueprints required.
- Valid Driver's License and legal capacity to drive a company vehicle required.
- Basic mechanical knowledge of machinery including hand tools, saws and grout pumps required.
- Working knowledge of crane signals.
- Ability to work outside year-round.
- Welding certification a plus.
- CDL is a plus (Valders location only).
- OSHA 10 or 30 training
