GENERAL DESCRIPTION

- Work with the Plant Manager to order materials needed for Patch and Finish.

- Work with Quality Control to coordinate inspections and approvals of products to ensure the highest level of quality for our customers.
- Participate in discussions about mix designs and help detect root cause of finish issues with Quality Control and Production.
- Work with Human Resources to actively recruit future patch and finish employees.
- Work with the Yard and Shipping Supervisor to schedule the movement of product.
- Maintain a professional relationship with the drafting, engineer and sales departments.
- Assist Team Lead(s) on the daily schedule and issues that arise.
- Sets up times for crew and number of crew members for patch and finish work and moves crews around for best efficiency.
- Lead, manage, and hold all patch and finish employees accountable.
- Train employees in new procedures to become more efficient.
- Be knowledgeable in proper rigging and handling of product.
- Understand the skills of sandblasting and water-blasting finish work.
- Help maintain a safe work environment and help educate employees on safe work practices.
- Complete special projects as requested and perform other duties as assigned.
